Dear Parents:

Below you will find a list of supplies that your child will need to start the first grade successfully. The supplies will be expected the first week of school. All of the supplies with an asterisk must be labeled with your child's name and class. Some of the supplies will be shared within our classroom community.

- 1 Large **Old** T-shirt or an **Old** Adult Button Down Shirt for Art
- 1 box of 12 colored pencils*
- 2 boxes of 8 fine-tip washable markers*
- 1 box of 16 crayons*
- 4 large glue sticks*
- 1 small Elmer's Glue
- 1 pair of scissors (*Fiskars blunt-ended are recommended*)*
- 1 package of Dry Erase Markers (thin)
- 1 old sock
- 1 ream of **white** or **colored** copy paper
- 6 packages of 3"x3" or 3"x5" post-it notes (keep some home)
- 3 boxes of 12 **sharpened** pencils
- 2 erasers*
- 1 stiff-sided pencil case containing at least 3 **sharpened** pencils daily*
- 1 box of 1 QUART sized *Zip-lock* bags (with zipper)
- 1 sturdy canvas activity bag with handles for indoor recess containing: pencils, crayons, and an activity book*
- 2 Disinfectant Wipes containers
- 1 Hand Sanitizer 8 FL OZ
- 3 packages of baby wipes
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 5 durable bottom-pocket folders: blue, green, red, orange, and purple.

- 3 marble notebooks*
- 1 clipboard
- 1 pair of child sized sunglasses
